Security and Cyber Week 2022, 27-30 June 2022, Tel Aviv University

Supply Chain Security – A breach in the supply chain can lead to financial costs, shortages and a loss of intellectual property. What tools are in place to secure the supply chain and how can we improve them?

Securing Critical Infrastructures – Urgent and growing cybersecurity challenges requires federal agencies to be ready to detect, monitor and control industrial control systems. From transportation, travel and water supply, to banking systems, electricity stations and HMOs, critical infrastructure protection is a essential part of cybersecurity.

Cloud Security – An event focused on examining the policies, technologies and applications in place to support the infrastructure of cloud computing, IP, data and more.

Startup Fest- On June 28th, we will run our annual Startup Exhibition, During this time, we look forward to running a series of roundtables and seminars focused on VCs, investments, startups and more

Finance & Cyber – Cryptography, zero-trust, SSIs, zero-knowledge, NFTs, blockchain and more – how this technology is reshaping the world and where it intersects with cybersecurity.
